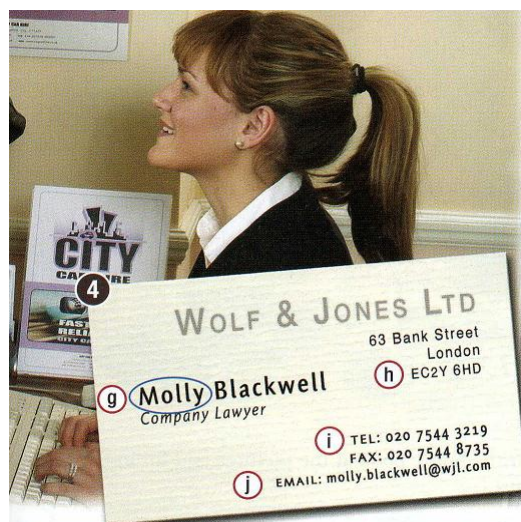
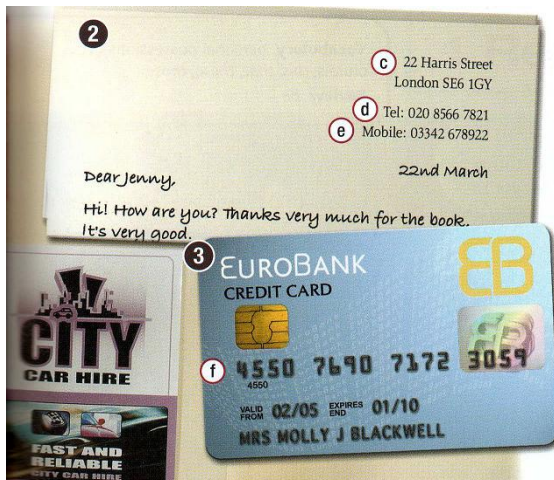

TIP! *You* and *Your* are singular and plural in English.

Subject pronouns and possessive adjectives

subject pronouns	I	you	he	she	it	we	they
possessive adjectives	my	your	his	her	Its	our	their

TIPS! We use subject pronouns with verbs: I am a teacher. They live in Rome.

We use possessive adjectives with nouns: My name's Rupert Giles. It's her book.

Verb to be: Negative, yes/no questions and short answers

NEGATIVE

We make negatives with *not*.

I'm not a teacher.

You/We/They aren't from Australia. (aren't = are not)

He/She/It isn't famous. (isn't = is not)

YES/NO QUESTIONS

Am I late?

Are you from Spain?

Is he/she a musician?

Is it from the USA?

Are we in room 5?

Are you from Sydney?

Are they French?

SHORT ANSWERS

Yes, I am. / No, I'm not

Yes, you are. / No, you aren't.

Yes, he/she is. / No, he/she isn't.

Yes, it is. / No, it isn't.

Yes, we are. / No, we aren't.

Yes, you are. / No, you aren't.

Yes, they are. / No, they aren't.
